

Ready For Autumn

Raleigh, N. C. — The new five-mile highway on the Great Smoky Mountains National Park is now expected to be completed in September and open for tourist traffic during the mountain color season. This is the Heintzger Ridge highway, connecting with the Blue Ridge Parkway at Soco Gap on U. S. 19 west of Waynesville.

Scheduled opening date was originally August 15, but Supt. John C. Preston of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park announced the postponement due to delays in construction. Although the new six-mile link will be opened to traffic this autumn, picnic and comfort facilities will not be completed, and formal opening of the skyway will not be held until next spring.

The Blue Ridge Parkway link from Soco to Mile High Overlook, completed last autumn and also six miles long is the other section of the Skyway commanding the most spectacular view of the Great Smoky Mountains. It is now expected to be open for travel except in winter when icing conditions may make it hazardous. During the last year it proved to be one of the most popular sections of the Blue Ridge Parkway.

The new six-mile link of the Blue Ridge Parkway connecting it directly with U. S. 70 at Oteen, 4 miles east of Asheville, was opened to traffic August 1. This gives a choice of routes from Asheville to Mt. Mitchell and Craggy Gardens via the Blue Ridge Parkway.

Other Western North Carolina scenic highways under construction, but which will not be completed until 1953, include a direct route from U. S. 19 near Bryson City to Fontana Dam, saving about 35 miles of travel from the East over present routes, and the four-mile segment of U. S. 70 east of Asheville between Old Fort and Greercrest that will eliminate the present narrow and twisting road between these points.
