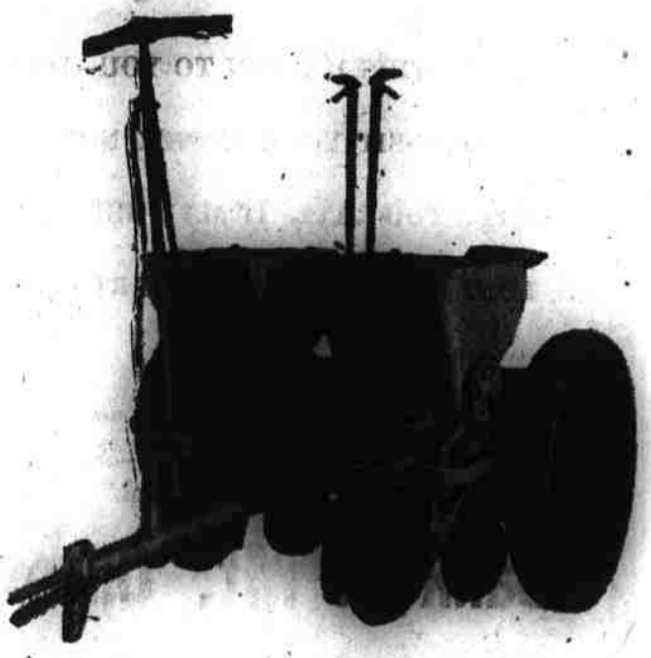
Wendell Teachey On USS Laffey
