## Chaplain Albert G. Karnell of Kinston Will Address Warsaw B&PW Club Feb. 22

Chaplain (Major) Albert G. Karnell is to be featured speaker at the annual Business and Professional Women's Club Banquet Monday, February 22 which will be held at the Warsaw School Cafeteria. The International Relations Committee will have charge of the program.

Chaplain Karnell is a graduate of Maryville College of Tennessee and received his theological degrees from Princeton Seminary, Princeton, New Jersey. He served Presbyterian parishes before entering the military service in May 1943. For two years after entering the chaplain ministry he served along the Burma Road in India, China and Burma as Supervising Chaplain of the Northern Air Service Area Command.

Returning to the U. S. from Japan in 1951, he was assigned duty at Sampson Air Base in New York. The inter-community program built up with the cities of Rochester, Syracuse, Auburn, Ithaca, Elmira and Geneva over which Chaplain

Kornell had charge, received national recognition. At Sampson, he wrote, directed and produced two monthly television shows and numerous radio programs, including shows that appeared on coast to coast NBC Radio and CBS Television. He arranged, produced, and presented concerts for the Sampson Air Force Base in N. Y., Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Illinois, Texas, California, Colorado, Wyoming and Maine.

Chaplain Karnell has travelled around the world both by plane and boat. He has lived and visited in France, Italy, Africa, Newfoundland, Canada, Mexico, Honolulu, Australia, India, China, Burma, Tibet, and Japan. His current assignment in Base Chaplain at Stallings Air Base, Kinston, North Carolina.

He has won wide recognition as an outstanding speaker on Aids to conditions and a keen observer of international affairs. His address, "The Enigma of Asia" has brought acclaim from churches, clubs, and civic organizations for its terse and lucid presentation of the global picture in the light of Asia.
