hours. A dampening device of some kind will help to distribute the water more uniformly than dampening by hand. The perforated sprinkler top that fits into the top of a bottle enables you to obtain even moisture distribution. Warm or hot water penetrates fabrics quicker and more evenly than cold water.

It is better to have too little rather than much moisture. An occasional dry spot can be easily dampened with a sponge and a little warm water during the ironing process.

Clothes should be dampened at least two or three hours prior to ironing. Starched items should be dampened four to six hours before they are ironed. If you are planning to iron in the morning then sprinkle the clothes the night before. In warm weather be careful about leaving clothes dampened too long for there is danger of mildew.

After dampening, articles should be wrapped in a plastic sheet or put in a plastic bag. Plastic does not absorb moisture and enables even distribution of moisture.

HINTS ON IRONING
Proper dampening is one of the secrets of good ironing, after clothes have been properly washed and starched. Garments should be dampened evenly, one piece at a time, and allowed to stand long enough for the moisture to penetrate the fabric.

The best overall rule is to dampen lightly. Much time and energy are wasted ironing pieces that are too damp. There is a difference between damp clothes and wet clothes.

Heavy cottons and linens require more moisture than do sheer materials. But even these should never be dampened to the wet stage.

Many materials such as washable crepes, rayons, and jerseys iron better if washed and rolled in a towel and let stand for several

State Accepts Last Four National 4-H Programs For 1954

Four more national 4-H award programs have been accepted by the State Extension Service, which completes the list offered for 1954.

The programs and the donors are: Bread Demonstration, Standard Brands, Inc.; Dress Revue, Simplicity Pattern Co., Inc.; Recreation and Rural Arts, United States Rubber Co., and Soil-Water Conservation, Firestone Tire & Rubber Co.

Awards are the same as last year excepting in the Bread Demonstration and Recreation-Rural Arts programs. In the first named program, gold-filled instead of sterling silver medals of honor will be awarded to county individuals and team members. In Recreation and Rural Arts program, County Cash awards have been changed to \$20.00 to a specified number of clubs in each state; the state winner receives an all-expense trip to the 1954 National 4-H Club Congress in Chicago instead of a \$37.50 scholarship, and the national awards are six \$300.00 college scholarships instead of 12 trips to the National 4-H Club Congress.

All four programs are conducted by the Cooperative Extension Service.
