News For Veterans

Veterans Administration announced its policy covering the participation of VA employees in activities of veterans' organizations. VA Circular No. 23, dated March 7, 1947, which discouraged VA employees from holding elective or appointive positions in veterans' organizations recognized for the presentation of claims against VA, is replaced by the following policy statement: "In determining the nature and extent of their outside activities, employees should constantly keep in mind that the VA must administer benefits to eligible veterans on an impartial basis.

Participation in any and all types of activities should be judged on the basis of whether it might result in a conflict between the private interest of the employee and his duty and obligation to the VA, or tend to create in the minds of other a suspicion of prejudice or favoritism that would be of embarrassment to the VA. "Particularly during their working hours employees will take care to avoid embarrassing the VA or their fellow employees by any improper activity in behalf of outside organizations."
