**What Veterans Are Asking**  
 Q—I would like to talk personally with a Veterans Administration representative. However, the VA Regional Office in Winston-Salem is too distant. Is there an official VA Office in Eastern North Carolina?  
 A—East of Raleigh the Veterans Administration has offices in the following three places only: Goldsboro, New Bern and Wilmington. You can see a Contact Representative at any of these offices. In Goldsboro the VA Office is located in the Borden Building.  
 Q—My National Service Life Insurance has been in force for several years. Since the beginning, my mother has been listed as my beneficiary. I recently married. Will my wife automatically become my beneficiary?  
 A—No. If you desire that your wife be beneficiary of your National Life Insurance it will be necessary to file a new beneficiary designation form with the VA Office.

**Farm Census About 75 Per Cent Over**  
 The 1954 Census of Agriculture is about 75 per cent completed in the fifteen counties covered by the field office at Fayetteville, according to Field Supervisor William L. Culbreth.  
 He stated that he was well pleased with the cooperation the census enumerators are receiving from farmers in this area and has high hopes of completing the canvass by an early date. He pointed out that the larger costs of the census and that cooperation of farmers will be a vital factor in keeping down the final cost of the undertaking.  
 Quick completion of the census will not only help in keeping costs down but will aid in prompt publication of the results, Culbreth said.  
 Q—In applying for Korean GI training, must I submit the original of my separation paper (DD Form 214) along with my application form, or will a carbon copy be satisfactory?  
 A—You may submit an official carbon copy of your DD Form 214 as evidence of your active service. It is not necessary to submit the original. If your separation paper has been recorded, a certified copy of the public record of discharge is also acceptable.  
 Q—What are some of the benefits available upon the death of a veteran?  
 A—A sum not to exceed \$150.00 is payable as partial or full reimbursement for burial expenses of a veteran; in addition, application can be made for a headstone or grave marker, an American flag to drape casket, and, if desired, application for burial in a National Cemetery can be made. It is also possible that death pension or compensation may be payable to widows, children, and parents in certain cases.
