### Fiscal Report

school buildings, equipment, and buses to be \$3,710,000.00. School Buildings and Equipment are insured in the amount of \$3,468,800.00. Bonded indebtedness amounted to \$271,000.00.

The comparison of estimated and actual revenue Exhibit shows \$78,171.56 more revenue was received during the fiscal year than had been estimated for all three school funds.

The Exhibit comparing the approved budget with actual expenditures shows a budget excess of \$26,406.14 over actual expenditures for the three funds.

The Schedule on Average Daily Attendance shows average daily attendance for the school year 1933-34 as follows: White Schools: Elementary 4482; High School 1450—Negro Schools: Elementary 3126; High School 813—Totals—Elementary 7618; High School 2263. This was an increase of 205 in the Elementary Schools, and an increase of 94 in High Schools.

The Dickson Charity Fund has Assets of \$6,503.79, consisting of deposits in bank of \$2,128.79; Notes Receivable \$4,150.00; and Postal Savings Certificates of Deposit of \$225.

**SCOPE OF AUDIT**

All recorded receipts were checked in detail, and were found properly credited. All disbursements were made by vouchers properly drawn and signed, which were checked against the records and found in order.

Bank accounts were reconciled and found in agreement with the records.
