

Income Tax Law Changes Call For A Special Look

(This article the fourth in a series describing the provisions of the Federal Income and Social Security tax laws as they affect farm people, was prepared by Charles E. Fugh, W. L. Turner, and C. W. Williams, extension farm management specialists, N. C. State College.)

When farmers compute their profit (or loss) from farming, itemized business deductions are subtracted from the gross income from farming. Certain expenditures used in the production of farm commodities such as purchased feed and fertilizer can be readily allocated to the farm business on an annual basis. Changes in the Federal income tax laws and more detailed bookkeeping procedures warrant special attention to some other farm business deductions. The treatment of depreciation and expenditures for soil and water conservation should be particularly noted in reporting farm profit (or loss) for the taxable year of 1955.

In figuring depreciation it is necessary to determine: (1) the useful life of each item on your depreciation schedule and (2) the basis for depreciation. Usually the basis of any property is its cost. If the property is its cost, if the property is materially improved, the additional costs, including hired labor for the improvements, are added to the basis. The "straight line" method of depreciation has been used most extensively by farmers. Under this method, the cost or other basis of the property less its estimated salvage value is deducted in equal annual amounts over the period of its estimated useful life. Two other methods of depreciation may now be used on new property having a useful life of three years or more. The "declining balance" method and the "sum of the years-digits" methods permit a larger proportion of the cost of the property to be recovered in the earlier period of its useful life.

Regardless of the method of depreciation used, you cannot deduct in one year the depreciation that you should have taken but did not take in a prior year. Therefore, complete records of your depreciable property will prevent the overlooking of an eligible item when you figure your depreciation deduction. Another special provision of the law permits certain expenditures for soil and water conservation or for the prevention of erosion to be deducted rather than capitalized. This feature applies specifically to certain outlays for the "treatment or moving of earth" on land used for farming. The deduction in any taxable year for such expenditures may not exceed 25 per cent of the gross income, derived from farming during that year. This type of deduction for soil and water conservation may be used initially without prior permission, but you must adopt this method for your first taxable year beginning after December 31, 1953, in which such expenditures are paid or incurred.

The "Farmers Tax Guide" provides a detailed explanation of new depreciation methods, expenditures for soil and water conservation, and other farm business deductions. This valuable pamphlet is available at the offices of the Internal Revenue Service and county agents.

What Questions Vets Are Asking

Q—Uncle Jesse blew out the lamp and then he, too, stretched out on his bed. "Good-night, boy," "Say your prayers!" "Saying them when you said good night!" Korean GI training has passed. Is it too late to switch? A. No. Even though your Korean GI Bill starting deadline has passed, you still may be permitted to switch to that training law. You may make the change either at the end of any regular enrollment period or at the time your World War II GI entitlement is exhausted.

Q—Is it possible for a veteran who lives in one state to get a GI loan to buy a home in another state? A.—Yes, it is possible; however, lenders generally confine their lending operations to certain specific areas. You should check your lender.

Q—I have just been discharged from the armed forces with a disability. I have applied to VA for service-connected compensation. If and when I am placed on the rolls, I intend to get a permanent GI insurance policy available to disabled Korea veterans. But in the meantime, I would like to be covered with insurance. Is there anything I can do now?

Q—I have been out of service for a year. I am planning to apply to VA for disability compensation. Since the armed forces have my medical records, will I be required to take a physical examination? A.—You will be required to take a VA physical examination. VA may waive the examination, under some circumstances, only for veterans who apply for compensation within six months after their separation from service.

Q—I am a "double duty" veteran with service in World War II and Korea. I am in training under the World War II GI Bill. I would like to switch to the Korean GI Bill, but I notice that my three-years-from discharge starting deadline for

Q—My daughter is receiving VA compensation payments, based on the death of my husband, a World War veteran who is over 18 years old, but she is attending school. Will the payments continue during her vacation periods, or will they be stopped when she is not actually in school?

Q—The payments will be continued during vacations, so long as evidence is submitted to VA showing that she was attending school at the end of one term, and plans to resume her studies at the next regular term.

Q—I want to change the beneficiaries of my GI insurance policy. Must I use a VA form for this purpose, in order for the change to be accepted by VA?

A.—It is not necessary to make the change on a VA form, although it is advisable to do so. You can change beneficiaries by writing VA a letter. Be sure to give your insurance number, full name, address and branch of service. And don't forget to sign your request.
