

Cows constantly bothered by flies and other insects simply will not produce as well as these that do not have to spend most of their time tighting these pests, stateg Marvin Senger, dairy specialist for the N. C. Agricultural Extension Service.

Senger declares that every effort should be made to keep flies off the cows. Controlling flies is one of the most important factors neces sary to keep up the summer milk flow, he emphasized.

Producers will need to rely on pyrethrum products for the control of biting flies on their animals giving milk. The use of malathion and diazinon in baits and in residual sprays for the control of house flies in dairies is expected to receive considerable attention this year according to Senger.
