

Bryce Younis Is Named Soil Conservation Committee Administrative Officer

Bryce R. Younis, 31 year old Davidson County native, has been named administrative officer for the State Soil Conservation Committee. It was announced today by David S. Weaver, committee chairman and director of the N. C. Agricultural Extension Service.

Younis will assume his new duties January 1. He has resigned as assistant manager of the agriculture and highway department of the Winston-Salem Chamber of Commerce, where he also acted as assistant manager of the Dixie Classic Fair.

Prior to his work with the Twin City chamber of commerce, Younis was a teacher of vocational agriculture in Davidson County. He served in the U. S. Navy in 1943 and 1946 and graduated from N. C.

State College in 1946 with a B.S. Degree in agricultural education. The position of administrative officer for the State Soil Conservation Committee is a newly created one. The 1957 General Assembly appropriated funds for the position.

Younis, as administrative officer, will act for the state committee in its dealing with locally elected district soil conservation boards. The committee is a coordinating unit authorized by the 1937 General Assembly to implement soil-saving programs throughout the State.

Since the enactment of North Carolina's Soil Conservation Districts Law in 1937 the entire state has been organized into formal soil conservation districts. The nation's first soil conservation district was

in North Carolina, in Anson County.

"While all of the state is organized," said Weaver in announcing

the appointment of Younis, the problem is far from being solved. Much of our soil is being released, sometimes to the extent of permanently impairing its productive capacity."
