State College Hints To Homemakers

MAKE GOOD SANDWICHES
The secret of good sandwiches is freshness; if made to eat right away, at the table or on the porch, sandwiches may be moist and delicious with plenty of dressing, crisp lettuce, or relish. But sandwiches made for eating hours later deserve careful planning, making, and packing to keep fresh appeal.
Sandwiches (without lettuce or mayonnaise) can be wrapped and frozen for use a week or two later. Allow three hours for thawing.
Most people like thinly sliced day-old bread can be sliced thin with a very sharp knife. If very fresh bread is used, chill the loaf before slicing.

Butter both sides of the sandwich to keep filling from soaking into the bread. For butter-spread, mix peanut butter, mayonnaise, or cheese spread with the soft butter. For extra flavor cream the butter spread with a little mustard, deviled ham, horseradish, chives, or favorite cheese.
Stack tea sandwiches in pans lined with foil, cover tightly with more foil and keep chilled until needed. Always chill meat, fish, or poultry sandwiches before packing. Chill for several hours or even overnight.
For moist fillings, mix with mayonnaise, chopped pickle, chili sauce or catsup. Or, use softened cream cheese, jelly, peanut butter, or orange juice.
SANDWICHES MEALS - In serving sandwich meals add a side relish, salad, or a fruit for good flavor combination, and use different beverages occasionally. Suggestions: Ham Sandwich with applesauce and hot or iced coffee, or with cole-slaw and lemonade. Chicken Salad Sandwich with cranberry jelly or watermelon pickle and chocolate milk. Egg Sandwich with tossed salad and anchovy dressing, iced tea or coffee, or with sweet pickles or spiced fruit and milk. Toasted Cheese Sandwich with a fruit cup, or salad and iced tea or coffee.
