during 1949 in claiming their retirement or family insurance benefts. By January, 1950 an estimated 3,000 person in Durham and the surrounding five counties were receiving about \$45,000 in monthly payments. 4.000 social security accounts

were established for persons going into coveded employment to the first time. 5,500 duplicate 3-2 6TP social security cards were furnished to persons who had changed their names or misplaced their cards.
