Jimmie Thomas and Miss Sara B. Durham.

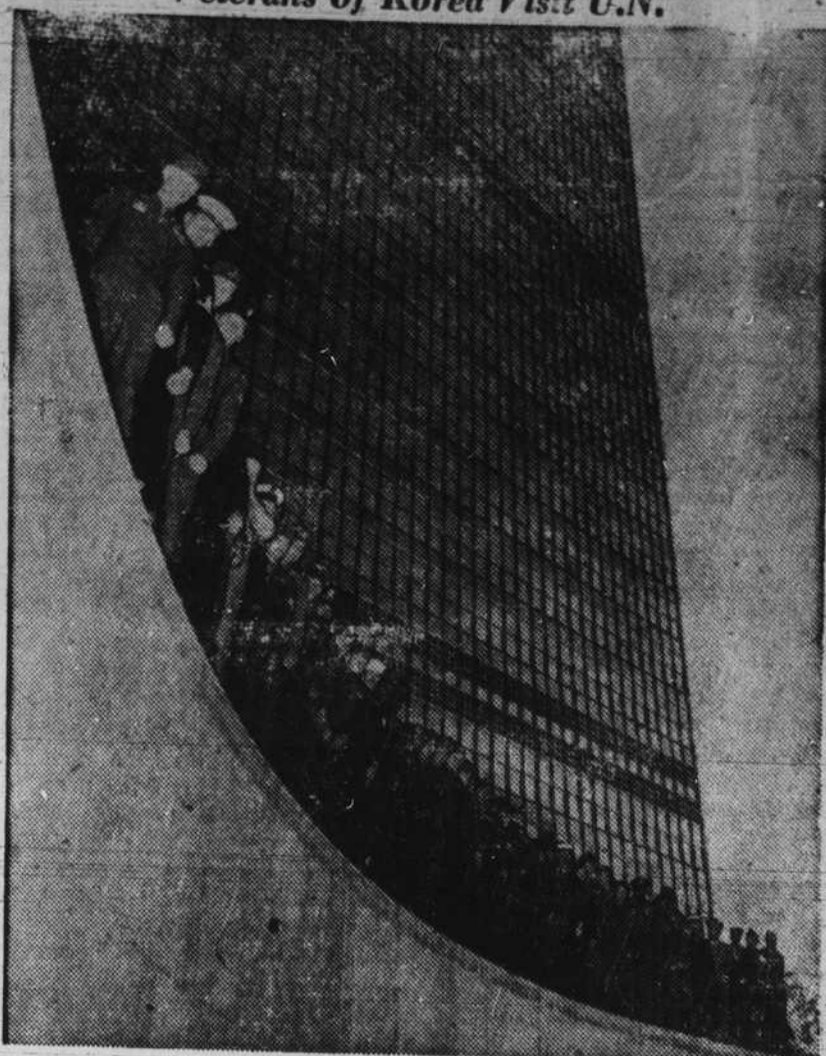
Circles Meet

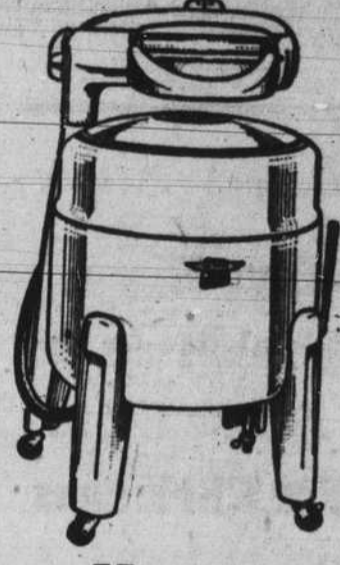

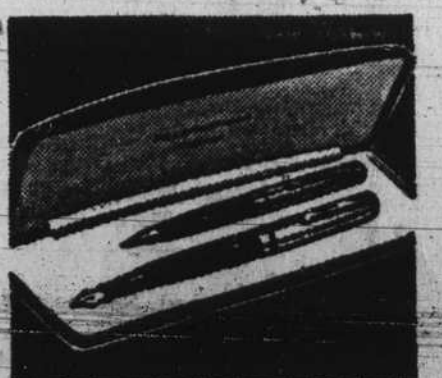

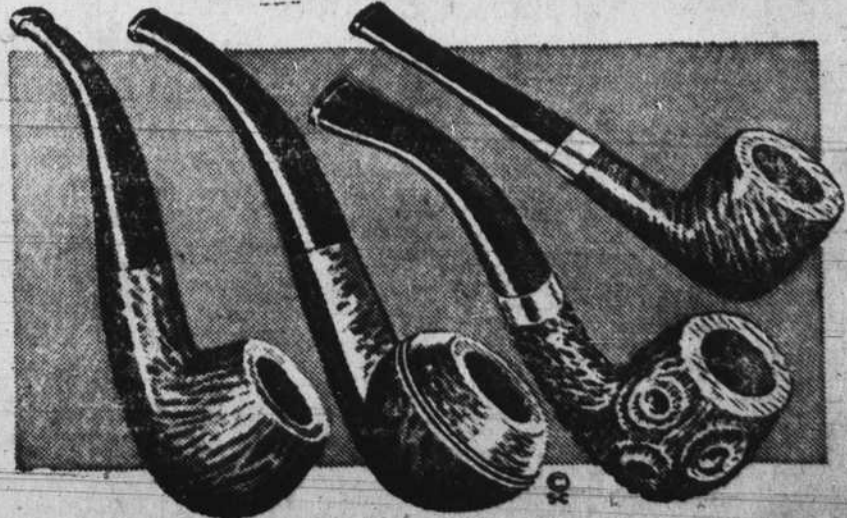
