The Land-Of Orange



"Improved pasture is about the only profitable use we can make of these hillsides," W. B. Shambly, Buckhorn, said last week. A good cover of orchard grass and ladino clover holds the soil and water on the slopes, and herd of high producing Holsteins make good use of the food produced. Recently surveyed broad base terraces will hold more soil and water on cropland for higher yields and greater profit on the Shambly farm.

Charles Bradshaw, Efland, received the complete soil and water conservation plan prepared for his farm in agreement with the local Neuse River Soil Conservation District. The plan is based on the long time capabilities of the land as determined by soil types, slope, and past erosion conditions.

Population check last week in cooperation with the N. C. Wildlife Resources Commission showed that the ponds of A. W. Freshwater, Mebane, and Alex Hamlett, Carr, were in good balance.

Dips with a minnow seine showed that the bass had reproduced satisfactorily this spring. These ponds were stocked at the recommended rate, the broom in the fall of 1954 and the bass in the spring of 1955. Checks on five other ponds showed overpopulation of broom.
