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HOME AGENT'S CORNER

Do you complain that you cannot have flowers and shrubs because of tree roots? Shade and roots do limit you, but there are plants that prefer the shade if there is enough moisture. John Harris, Extension Horticulturist, has these suggestions. The secret is to select plants adapted for the shade and then thoroughly prepare the soil before planting. To give the plants an even break, remove the small roots from the bed and work into the soil two to three inches of peat moss or other forms of organic matter.
 If you have a shady terrace, try growing plants in pots or flower boxes above the ground. I find this very satisfactory. Make your box out of treated redwood or cypress.
