

Curriculum for new Orange high school is approved

The Orange County Board of Education has approved a proposed curriculum for the new Orange High School, Senior and Junior, including German as a third foreign language, along with plans for a two-course program.

Under the two-course program, students would elect as early as the eighth grade whether they would pursue the academic or college preparatory route to a diploma or a general, or business, track.

Both courses would require 18 units for graduation beginning with high school beginners next year.

The new curriculum is the result of recent studies by citizens committees planning for the new school to be built on the 100-acre tract north of Hillsboro and the plans of the Board of Education for enriching the local school program.

The academic or college preparatory course requires four units of English, three of social

studies, (U. S. History, World History and 1 other); three in Mathematics (Algebra 1 & 2 and Geometry); three in Science (General Science, Biology and 1 other); two in Foreign Language (Latin 1 & 2, or French 1 & 2); Physical Education 1 unit; and Electives 2 units.

The general or business course will require four units of English, three or social studies (American History and two others); Mathematics 2 units; Science (Biology and 1 other); Phy-

sical Education 1 unit; commercial subjects 6 units.

The Junior High curriculum includes a wide range of electives including remedial reading, mechanical drawing in one of the Industrial Arts courses as well as French, Spanish and German in addition to Latin.

The new Senior High curriculum will be instituted as the interests of the student body justify and qualified staff can be secured. It includes some 20 courses for each grade, including such

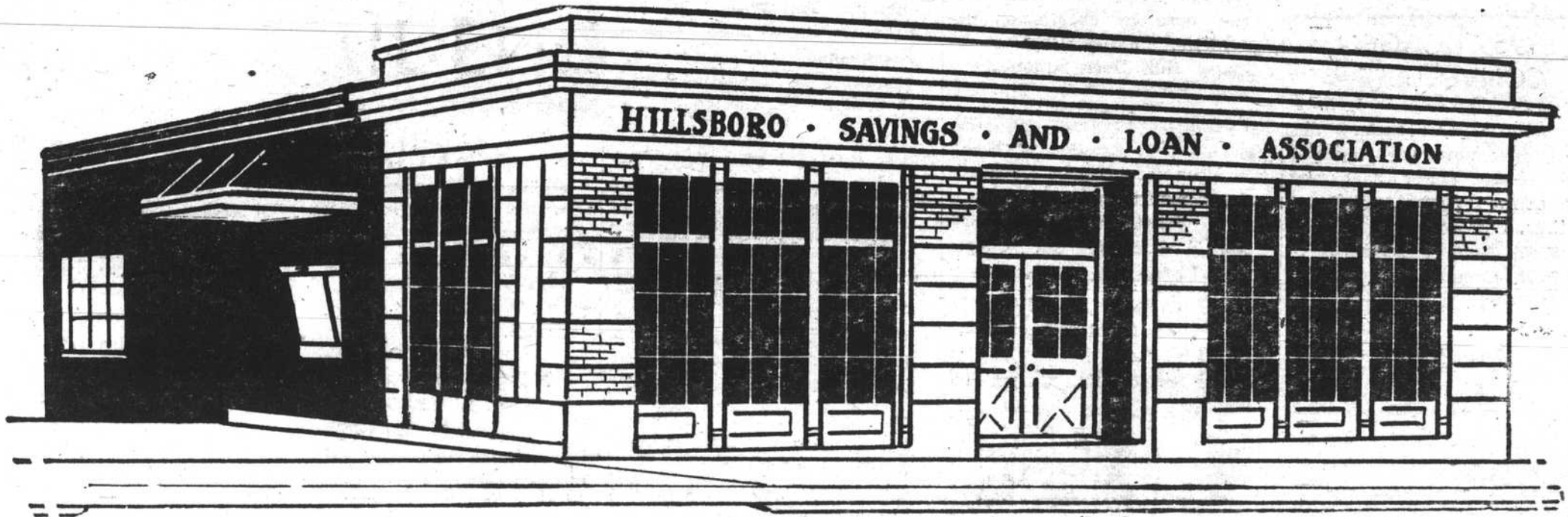
new offerings as creative writing, speech and drama, industrial arts, consumer music, library science, etc.
