

## Station WUNC University Day rites all set for tomorrow

### back on the air

The radio voice of the University, WUNC-FM, went on the air Monday (Oct. 8) for its tenth year of broadcasting and its second year as a maximum power station.

With the increase to 50,000 watt power last winter, the station now offers coverage of the entire central portion of North Carolina, together with some parts of Virginia and South Carolina. Located at 91.5 on the dial, WUNC-FM can be picked up within a 100-mile radius of Chapel Hill. Broadcast time is from 6 p. m. to 11 p. m.

The station is operated entirely by students. It offers the finest in music, news and dramatic programs from the BBC, Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, French Broadcasting System and other domestic and foreign networks.

The 160th birthday of the University will feature an address by Robert F. Goheen, president of Princeton University, who speaks at "University Day" exercises tomorrow at 11:15 a. m. in Memorial Hall.

Chancellor William B. Aycock will preside at the exercises which will begin with a faculty procession. The event will commemorate the laying of the first building on the campus of the oldest state university in the United States.

University students will be dismissed from 11 and 12 o'clock classes to attend University Day exercises on October 12. Trustees, alumni and visitors will observe the events.

Robert Goheen was selected for the presidency of Princeton in the fall of 1956 when he was 37 years of age. At that time, he was serving as Assistant Pro-

He was advanced to the rank of Professor of Classics prior to his induction. Dr. Goheen is Princeton University's 16th president.

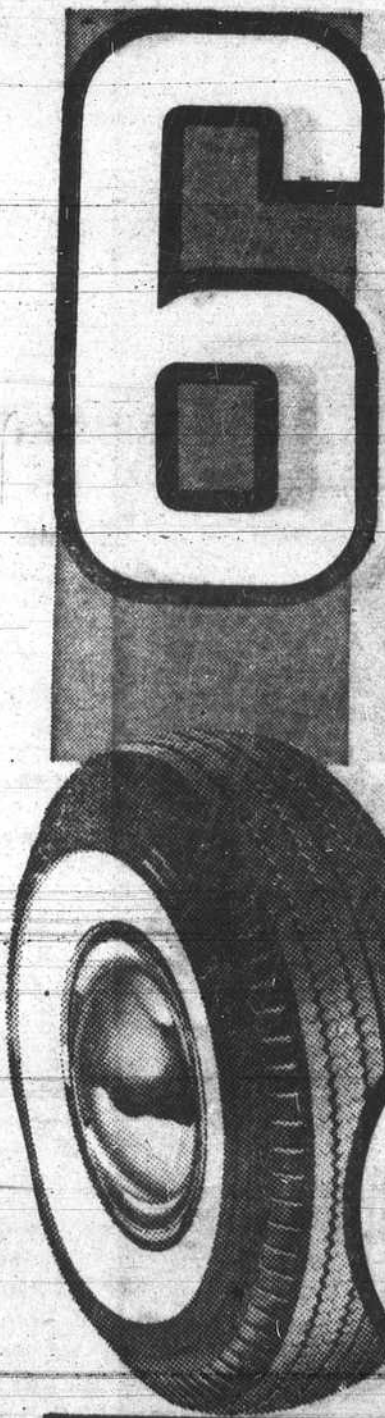
