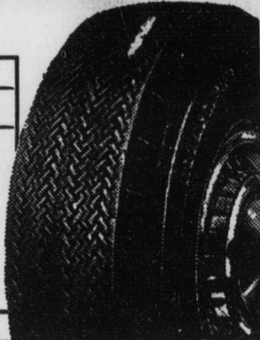

Since none of my campaigns have engendered any appreciable amount of ill will or bitterness, I can sincerely say also that I have but the kindest of feelings for all those who have opposed me from time to time in any or all of my campaigns.
