Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Farmville, North Carolina, at the office of the Clerk in said Town, until Oct. 1st, 1919, at nine o'clock, p. m., when they will be publicly opened, for the purchase of \$100,000 Local Improvement Bonds of said Town, of the denomination of \$1,000 each, dated October 1st, 1919, and bearing interest at the rate of six per centum per annum, payable semi annually. Said bonds will

mature serially, three bonds on October 1st, in each of the years 1920 to 1923 inclusive, four bonds on October 1st in each of the years 1924 to 1927 inclusive, five bonds on October 1st in each of the years 1928 to 1931 inclusive, six bonds on October 1st in each of the years 1932 to 1935 inclusive, seven bonds on October 1st in each of the years 1936 to 1939 inclusive. Principal and interest will be payable at the Hanover National Bank, New York City. The bonds will be coupon bonds, with the privilege of conversion into fully registered bonds.

Proposals must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, marked on the outside "proposals for Bonds," and addressed to T. E. Joyner, Town Clerk, Farmville, North Carolina. Bidders must deposit with said Town Clerk, before making their bids, or present with their bids, a certified

check drawn to the order of the Town of Farmville, upon an incorporated bank or trust company, or a sum of money, for or in an amount equal to two per centum of the face amount of bonds bid for, to secure the municipality against any loss resulting from the failure of the bid-

der to comply with the terms of his bid. The purchaser must pay accrued interest from the date of delivery. The bonds cannot be sold at less than par and accrued interest.

Successful bidders will be furnished with the opinion of Messrs. Reed, McCook & Hoyt,

of New York City, that the bonds are valid and binding obligations of the Town of Farmville.
