To The Property Owners of The Town of Farmville Abutting Upon the Paved Streets in Said Town:

Notice is hereby given that the assessment roll of pavement in the Town of Farmville has been turned over to me by the Board of Commissioners as provided by Chapter 56 of the Public Laws of 1915 and any assessment contained in said assessment roll may be paid to the undersigned at any time before the expiration of thirty days after the first publication of this notice without any addition, but unless said assessments are paid within said time, they will bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum from the date of the confirmation of the assessment roll and shall become due and payable on the date which the taxes are payable. If, however, any of the abutting property owners do not wish to pay for said assessment in cash, they may, by giving notice of the fact in writing to the undersigned within thirty days after the first publication, have the option and privilege of paying for said assessment in ten equal annual installments. If any assessment thereof is not paid within said time, it shall be subject to the same penalties as are now prescribed for unpaid taxes in addition to the interest therein provided for.
