Born in Adams, Mass., the came of Quaker stock, and early devoted herself to "temperance" (the prohibition of those days) and to the abolition of slavery.

For several years after the Civil war Miss Anthony endeavored to secure an interpretation of the fourteenth and fifteenth amendments which would allow women to vote. Finally, in 1872, at Rochester, N. Y., she tried to force an interpretation by voting at the polls. She was arrested and fined. She refused to pay the
