SAUNDERS KILLED BY JULE PAGE IN AFFRAY SATURDAY

William Saunders, Colored Man of Carolina Township Shot and Killed in An Attack Upon Jule Page With Bush Axe at Page's Home Saturday Night; Coroner Exonerates Page.

William Saunders, colored man of Carolina township, was shot and killed by Jule Page, also colored, following an altercation occurring at Page's home Saturday night. The entire load of a shotgun entered the neck and chest of Saunders who was found lying in the road in front of the Page home about half an hour after the shooting is said to have occurred. Coroner Wilkerson and Sheriff Dudley conducted an inquest over the body of the dead man Sunday morning, the jury a short time after returning a verdict that Saunders came to his death by wounds inflicted by a gun in the hands of Jule Page, and that Page fired in defense of himself and home.

Page was not at home when Saunders began to get rough, but appeared a short time later and heard him using language alleged to have been of the most vile and profane kind. Page asked Saunders to leave the house, but he refused to do so, whereupon the head of the family grasped the visitor by the collar and pushed him out the door into the front yard.

Everyone thought Saunders had left the premises, but when Page stepped out he saw and went to the door to look outside, he was viciously struck by Saunders who made a pass at him with a dangerous looking bush axe. Page immediately opened fire. Saunders was seen to put his hands to his head and walk towards the gate as if going home.

It was not thought at the time that he was seriously injured, but when members of the party started for home about a half hour later they found his body lying in the road, with face and neck bleeding from wounds inflicted by the discharge from the shot.
