Good Dairy Cows
Pay Best Profit Ten good cows are more, profitable than 20 low prodicers. In fact, low producers are often an expense rather than a proft, de-
clared R. H. Ruffner, head of the clared husbandry department at State College. A cow giving six quarts of milk
a day just about pays for her feed, a day just about pays for her feed,
Ruffner said. She pays nothing for
stable rent stable rent or for the labo
for her care nad milking.
for her care nad milking.
But a cow giving 10 quarts of
milk daily will yield a net profit of milk daily will yield a net profit of $\$ 40$ a year. Ten such cows will pro-
duce a clear profit of $\$ 400$ a yearduce a clear profit of $\$ 400$ a year.
Cows giving more milk produce an even larger return.
The exact figure, of course, will vary with local conditions, the price of milk, and the cost of feed, RuffMany dairymen who did not make money last year are thinking of buy-
ing highpriced cows. In many instances they would do better to sell their lowest producers and endeavor to raise the
animals:
