Farmers Get Higher Ratings For Lumber

Higher priority ratings for softwood lumber required for essential agricultural uses are provided in an amendment to the softwood lumber conservation order...

"Automatic preference ratings are not provided for new softwood lumber to be used for such agricultural purposes as construction of new dwellings, garages, machine sheds, repair shops and similar buildings..."

He said the amendment makes it compulsory for dealers to fill purchase orders carrying a preference rating if they have the material on hand and do not have orders pending with higher priority ratings.
