**Expiration Dates GI Benefits Listed By Pitt Service Officer**

Arthur B. Corey, Veterans' Service Officer for Pitt county, advises that the time limits in which veterans and their survivors and dependents are entitled to exercise rights, benefits and privileges to which they are entitled, as revised August 1, 1947, are as follows:

**NINETY DAYS AFTER DISCHARGE:** Application for reinstatement in permanent job held at time of induction.

**SIX MONTHS AFTER DISCHARGE:** Veterans may enlist in Reserve Corps in same grades held at time of discharge, within six months of discharge.

**UNTIL NINE MONTHS AFTER DISCHARGE:** Veterans who have not completed USAFI educational courses begun in service are eligible to complete such courses and take end-of-course examinations.

**UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 1947:** Veteran or serviceman may apply for entry of alien fiancée or fiancé to U. S. under nonquota immigration status. (Applies only to aliens whose country's immigration quota is over-subscribed.)

**UNTIL JANUARY 1, 1948:** Reinstatement of term National Service Life Insurance without physical examination.

**UNTIL JULY 1, 1948:** Applications may be made by leg amputees for free automobiles costing not in excess of \$1600.

**UNTIL AUGUST 1, 1948:** A beneficiary who began to receive NSLI payment before Sept. 30, 1944, has the right to change option of settlement.

**UNTIL SEPTEMBER 1, 1948:** Applications for terminal leave pay may be made.

**UNTIL DECEMBER 28, 1948:** Applications may be made for expeditious naturalization of alien spouses and alien minor children of citizen members of U. S. Armed Forces or honorably discharged veterans.

**UNTIL JANUARY 1, 1950:** Veterans who did not acquire NSLI while in service, may still apply. Those who make application before 1950 will not be denied a policy by reason of any disability incurred in or aggravated by service.

**UNTIL JULY 25, 1951:** Veteran who dies within three years of separation from active service is considered to have been fully insured and to have received wages of \$160 a month during the period of active Armed Forces service for the purpose of calculating benefits due to next-of-kin under the Social Security Act.

**UNTIL JULY 25, 1952:** Payments of Readjustment Allowances under G. I. Bill end.

**UNTIL JULY 25, 1952:** All Federal Civil Service positions of guards, elevator operators, messengers and custodians are reserved for veterans only.

**UNTIL Sept. 27, 1954:** Veteran has preferred right of application for 90 days before general public may apply for homestead entry on public lands reopened or reclamation projects opened for settlement.

**July 25, 1956:** All Education and Training under GI Bill and Public Law No. 16 must be completed.

**UNTIL JULY 25, 1957:** Veterans may apply for Loan Guarantee for purchase of homes, farms, or businesses, under GI Bill.

**2 Years After Discharge or July 25, 1947, whichever is later:** Veterans may apply for Readjustment Allowance under GI Bill.

**4 Years After Discharge or July 25, 1947, whichever is later:** Veterans may initiate Educational Rights of GI Bill.

**5 Years After Acquiring National Service Life Insurance (if term insurance dated after January 1, 1948):** Conversion privilege to permanent type.

**8 Years After Acquiring National Service Life Insurance (if term insurance dated before Jan. 1, 1948):** Conversion privilege to permanent type.

**10 Years After Discharge or 15 Years After June 22, 1944 (whichever is later):** Appeals may be made for Review of Discharge.

**Lifetime:** Hospitalization, medical treatment, domiciliary care, outpatient treatment, prosthetic appliances for veterans having service-connected disabilities under certain conditions. Application for pension, but compensation at "wartime rates" is based upon service between December 7, 1941, and July 26, 1947.

**2 Years After Death:** Dependents may apply to Veterans Administration for burial benefits.
