MODERN DANCE NO PLACE IN CHRISTIANITY

Dr. Zeno Wall Presents Five Arguments Against The Public Dance

Advertisement Warsaw Dance And Arrest of Mount Olive Boy Here Cited

The attitude of the Baptist church of Goldsboro towards the modern dance was set forth by Dr. Zeno Wall Sunday night as follows:

- 1. The participants are doing wrong. 2. We should pray for them. 3. We should warn them of their danger. 4. When they do wrong, we should go to them and point the errors of their way.

The pronouncement of Dr. Wall followed a terrific denunciation of the modern dance.

Taking what he called their own testimony, Dr. Wall quoted from dance literature, and cited what he termed incriminatory behavior.

The first of these was an advertisement of a dance given by the Warsaw post of the American Legion last fall...

The second instance was the arrest here Friday night of a poor Mount Olive boy who came to the dance in an intoxicated condition.

The third was Bishop Rulan's indictment of the Friday night dance. This young man, Dr. Wall stated, claims he has witnessed the dances and debauchery of the Barbary Coast...

Fourth, Dr. Wall stated that statistics showed that over 50 per cent of the 200,000 women who lost their virtue in a given year, assigned their downfall to the modern dance.

Fifth, the licentiousness and moral depravity displayed in that famous dance of Biblical times when Moses went to the top of the mountain to commune with the Lord.

Dr. Wall was emphatic in the denunciation of the modern dance. He holds that the modern dance has no place in the scheme of Christianity, and he exhorted all those worthy of the name of Christians...
