### FUNERAL OF M. B. PETERSON AT STANLEY TUESDAY.

STANLEY, Dec. 24.—Funeral services over the remains of the late M. B. Peterson, who died suddenly at his home here Sunday, were held at Christ Lutheran church here this afternoon. The pastor, Rev. A. L. Boliek, performed the ceremonies in the presence of a large gathering of friends and relatives.

Deceased was 67 years old and had made his home here for more than 30 years, during all of which time he had been closely identified with all the interests of the community. He is survived by his widow, who was Miss Lillie Pinchback, and the following children: Charles Peterson, Stanley; Mrs. Milton Whitener, of Pennsylvania; Mrs. Bertie Black, of Lenoir; Mrs. Ethel Goodman, of Charlotte; Robert Peterson, of Chattanooga, Tenn.; Mrs. Mamie Fletcher, of West Virginia; Miss Bessie Peterson, of Charlotte, and Miss Lillian Peterson, at home.

Mr. Peterson was a son of the late Rev. Jesse R. Peterson, who was, a generation ago, one of the best known Lutheran preachers in this part of the country. Deceased was a man of sterling qualities and was held in very high esteem by all who knew him.

### Cotton Ginned.

According to report made by Mr. W. E. Johnson to the Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce, there were 7,934 bales of cotton ginned in Gaston county from the 1918 crop prior to December 15th, as compared with 4,828 bales ginned prior to the same date in 1917.
