"Order No. 2797, issued by the Post master General, under date of February 17th, 1919, cancels all 5 cent toll rates and makes the minimum station to station rate 10 cents for distances of 12 miles, or less and establishes new rates:

"When the station to station rate is 10 cents, the completed person to person rate is 15 cents. The completed appointment and messenger rate is 20 cents. The report charge is 5 cents. The initial perid for person to person messages at the 15 cent rate will be 3 minutes, and the overtime rate 5 cents for each additional

"These changes and new rates offertive at 12:01 a. m., February 21, 1919, " The above order restores the privilege of making person-to-person calls to towns within a radius of twelve miles of each other, which privilege was recently with drawn by a previous order of the Post master General.
