Beginning Monday, July 28th, the city wagons will make one round of the city to haul away all garbage that is properly placed. The city will not undertake to go into the premises and gather up limbs, cinders or any other matter that requires to be shoveled or gathered up. Only such matter will be moved as is placed in boxes or barrels that can be carried by one man to the wagon in the street. Barrels should be placed as conveniently as possible near the driveway, so that they can be quickly carried to the street and dumped into the wagon, but should not be placed on the edge of the street where they will be unsightly.

During the summer months it is absolutely imperative that premises should be kept in the cleanest and most sanitary manner, so as to avoid spread of disease, and all property owners are strongly urged to cooperate with the city health department in an effort to make Gastonia
