### DETROIT JAILS FULL OF REDS.

DETROIT, MICH., Nov. 10.—Virtualy every Detroit police station, jail and other place of confinement today held at least a few of the federal prisoners, alleged radicals, agitators rounded up in trials begun last week. It was indicated today that efforts to check activities of the alleged disciples of direct action would be continued for sometime.

All told approximately 1,000 persons have been arrested here. Smaller groups were taken at Jackson and Atlanta, and further arrests are expected, the authorities estimated.

PARIS, Nov. 10.—The supreme council has decided not to interfere with the German municipal elections now being held in areas where elections are to be taken under the peace treaty. It has decided, however, that such elections will be in no way binding upon the allies which will disregard them when the final settlement of affairs in the districts in question is effected.

RALEIGH, Nov. 10.—The Baptist State Convention meets in Raleigh Tuesday morning for its 88th annual session, a feature of the convention being the 75 Million dollar Campaign. Arrangements have been made for entertaining the visiting Baptists.

For B. W. Spilling, of Kinston, will call the convention to order Tuesday morning. The opening session will be presided over by Rev. Dr. Clyde Turner, pastor of the First Baptist church of Greensboro. In the afternoon of the first day's session the "Why" of the 75 Million Dollar Campaign will be discussed, and the "What" of the campaign comes up for settlement Tuesday night.
