TEEN TROUBLES By John Douglas, M.D., and Mary Douglas

Question: I don't want to make people mad, but it seems to me like I'm always losing friends. Somebody is always getting mad at me. How can I find out what is wrong?

Answer: Not knowing the exact circumstances, it's difficult to advise you. However, there are some very good rules to guide you in taking stock of yourself—which is the first step toward making and keeping friends.

For example:

1. Never break a confidence. If someone tells you a secret, keep it. The only exception to this rule is when it concerns something your parents should know about.
2. Try to see something good in every person you know. It's there. All you have to do is search for it. If his faults outnumber his good points, try to understand what it is in his background and environment which causes these unpleasant traits. In other words, try to understand and sympathize with his problems. There is always a reason for personality quirks.
3. Become a good listener. Most of us hear very little of what is being said to us. We're too busy thinking about what we're going to say when he stops talking. Look straight at the person who is talking. Hear what he says. And show some interest in it.
4. "Put yourself out" — "Go to some trouble" for your friends. Become known as one who does favors for people. It's a wonderful reputation to have.
5. Smile a lot. A smile can open doors that money or prestige will never unlock. A smile does something to people. It makes them remember you longer than any other one thing about you.
6. Develop enthusiasm. Enjoy doing things. And show your enjoyment. Life is wonderful, you know. Every day is simply full of interesting events. One never knows
