Raleigh, May 22—Failure to comply with the State laws for the reporting of contagious diseases and vital statistics caused several prosecutions by the State Board of Health during the week, with convictions in local courts.

Rastus Butler, a white citizen of Sampson county, failed to report a case of whooping cough in his family. He had no physician. The child suffering with whooping cough was taken to a public funeral and later the disease developed among the children of four other families who were present. Twenty cases are charged to contact with this child. Mr. Butler was fined five dollars and costs.

T. M. Farrell, Jr., local undertaker in Sampson county was fined five dollars and costs for having buried a body without obtaining death certificate.

An additional inspector for the State health department will be placed in the field the first of June and the effort to strictly enforce the laws with regard to promptly reporting contagious diseases and proper compliance with the vital statistics law will be intensified.
