At the time and place and under the officials named below and pursuant to petition duly signed by the number of qualified voters required by statute and approved by the County Board of Education, a special election has been ordered to be held in and for the Mildouson Graded and High School District to determine whether a maximum special school tax of 30 cents on the one hundred dollars valuation of property may hereafter be levied in and for said District, the present maximum special school tax for said District being 20 cents. The Mildouson Graded and High School District is composed of the old Dundarrach Special Tax District bounded as follows:

Beginning near H. L. McGoogan's at the Beaver Dam Swamp; thence North with the line of the Antioch Special Tax District to a point northwest of J. A. McMillan's place; thence including McMillan's, D. McInnis' and A. A. Willford's land, northeastwardly to the Little Marsh; thence south with said Marsh to the crossing on road leading from D. Z. McGougan's to the D. W. McGougan place; thence with said road to D. W. McGougan's, including his place, N. S. Tolar's and A. J. Marley's, to the County line; thence with said line to the Big Marsh; thence with said Marsh to the mouth of Beaver Dam Swamp, and up said swamp to the beginning; and of the old Arabia Special Tax District, bounded as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of Lumber Bridge Township on Big Rockfish Creek and runs with the Township line south to the Wire Road near Milton Baxter's; thence with the Wire Road to Alex. Tyner's residence and including his place; thence with the Little Marsh Road to George Livingston's residence and including his place; thence across the Little Marsh to the outer edge of Dr. J. V. McGougan's land; thence, including his land, to Baxter's Ford; thence with a direct line to Sandy Grove Church on the Wire Road;

thence with the Wire Road to the old Davis Bridge on Big Rockfish Creek; thence with Big Rockfish Creek to the beginning corner.
A new registration is ordered for the election. The books will be open for the registration of voters on the 9th of June 1924, and will be kept open by the registrar each day thereafter, Sundays excepted, from 9 o'clock A. M. until sunset until including the second Saturday before the election. During the period when the books are open for the registration of voters the said registrar will attend at the voting place, Mildouson School Building on Saturdays for the registration of voters. Those favoring the tax increase will vote a ballot having printed thereon "For Increase of Local Tax" and those not favoring the same will vote a ballot having printed thereon "Against Increase of Local Tax."

Place of Election: Mildouson School Building.


