Howard Garriss, Extension plant outhologist at State College, says that his year some growers used Oxford. tobacco, which is resistant to Granville wilt, and were disappoint-ded with it. The reason was that the tobacco was suffering from black shank, and the grower should have own one of the Oxford strains 1. 3, or 4.


