Ways and means of remedying the situation were talked about and first it was naturally suggested that an appeal be made to the company to improve their service.

However, further discussion re-vealed that this would probably do no good, as several persons present stated that appeals had been made without result. Neill McFadyen, mayor of Ramford, stated that he had been looking into the town rec-ords to find the terms of the company's franchise here but that up to now he had been unable to find a

Our idea is that this town should get a competent lawyer to investigate this franchise and then appeal to the Utilities Commission or take whatever other action necessary to have the franchise of the Carolina FOR SALE—Nice young turkeys.
