

The tiny train shown above is the Seaboard Railway's first. The locomotive was built in England and shipped to America by sailing vessel. Christened the "Raleigh," this half-pint engine was running from Portsmouth, Virginia, to Raleigh, North Carolina, in 1846. The "Raleigh" weighed ten tons and boasted a top speed of 20 miles per hour. Thus she was the marvel of her time.

The giant locomotive below the "Raleigh" is the "Rail Master"-world's largest and most powerful diesel-electric. Generating 3,000 horsepower in a single unit, the big fellow weighs in at nearly 600,000 pounds and will cruise along at 120 miles per hour. The train in tow is Seaboard's famous "Silver Meteor."
