State College Hints To Farm Homemakers

Economy is the watchword of the well-dressed women. When planning a spring wardrobe, choose a good basic color - preferably black, brown, navy or dark green.

A good way to train children not to leave a ring around the bathtub is to place a bath brush for tub-scrubbing in easy reaching distance.

New nylon bristle brushes are priceless for keeping things clean in the kitchen. The vegetable brushes are good for cleaning vegetables in a jiffy. Long stemmed brushes are excellent for hard-to-clean things such as your glass coffee-maker.

Don't throw away a good pair of galoshes just because the inside is dirty and likely to ruin your hose. The lining can be cleaned as easily as the outside. Simply turn the overshoes inside out. Put them in a tub of warm, soapy water to soak a few minutes. Then with a small fairly soft brush, scrub over the entire lining. For very soiled galoshes, you may need to repeat the operation.


