**Farmer friends, we have many reports of excessive boll weevil damage in Hoke County. The average infestation of all fields checked is over 50 per cent punctured squares.**

**We recommend the use of BHC (3 per cent BenzineHexaChloride, 5per cent DDT) as a dust applied at 6 to 10 pounds per acre. Any good duster, Hand or tractor operated, will do the job, or you may secure the help of Mr. Clyde Christopher to dust by airplane at \$1.00 per acre. He may be contacted at the local airport.**

**Should you desire our help in securing the above poison materials we will be glad to secure them for you at cost if possible.**

**If you don't make cotton we will miss your seed.**
