

Farmers' Income Up 20 Per Cent

Raleigh, Aug. 5-Cash income of North Carolina farmers in 1946 was about 20 per cent higher than in 1945, it was reported today by the Federal-State Crop Reporting Service of the State Department of Agriculture.

Total cash receipts in 1946 totaled \$764,404,000. The total in 1945 was \$638, 414,000.

Practically all of the increase came, the report stated, from marketing of crops, which brought farmers \$633,394,000 as again-Saturday with Mr. and Mrs. N. st \$508, 159,000 in 1945. 


