### Farmers Are Urged To Get Soil Tested

Farmers wanting their soils tested are urged by Dr. Ivan E. Miles, chief of the Soil Testing Division of the State Department of Agriculture, to take samples as soon as possible and send them to the division in order to avoid the usual late winter and spring rush.

Quicker service can be given by the division during the next few weeks because generally the flow of incoming samples slows during winter months, Dr. Miles explained.

He also pointed out that having soils tested now would help speed the movement of fertilizer, as farmers can ascertain the correct kinds of plant food needed and place their order early.

There is no charge for the soil-testing service. Farmers may send in samples from as many fields as they desire. Instructions for taking samples, and containers for shipping the soil to Dr. Miles, may be obtained from county farm agents, local soil conservationists, agriculture teachers and other farm agencies.

Peanut growers in North Carolina will go to the polls December 9 to decide whether or not marketing quotas are to be in effect on 1948, 1949, and 1950 peanut crops.
