And Thou, Bethlehem

This is Bethlehem as it appears today, built upon the ruins of the ancient town in Palestine. The highway in the foreground follows approximately the course of the old road running south from Nazareth.

Along this ancient thorough fare trudged Joseph and Mary, on their way to Jerusalem to be taxed. We aried with their journey, they spent the night in a khan at Bethlehem. Here Mary's child was born, and they called his name Jesus.

For the prophet had said: "And thou Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, art not the least among the princes of Judah; for out of thee shall come a Governor who shall rule my people Israel.

The incidents at Bethlehem that first Christmas morning when Jesus was born, have more profoundly affected human life than any other event in world history. For the spirit of that humble child has become the most potent influence in modern life.

Millions of churches, dedicated to the worship of God, are founded upon the faith born at Bethlehem. And countless millions of people turn to that faith for strength and comfort in life, and for hope of a better life beyond the grave.
