Such food items as honey, peanut butter, fresh and frozen fish, eggs, and fruit spreads also are on the plentiful list for August.



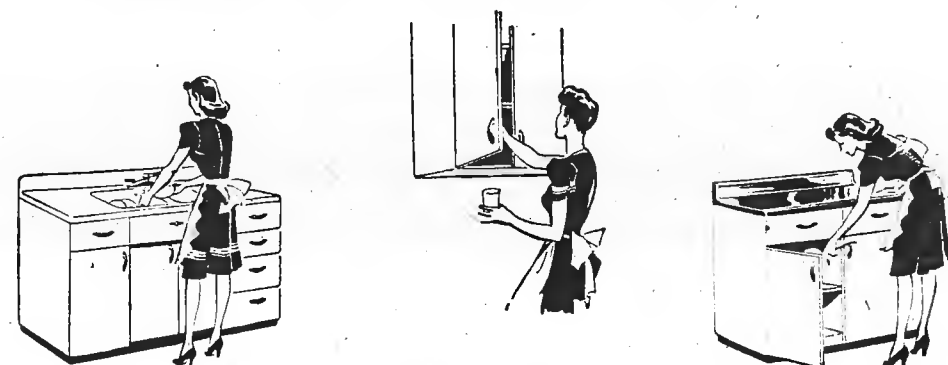

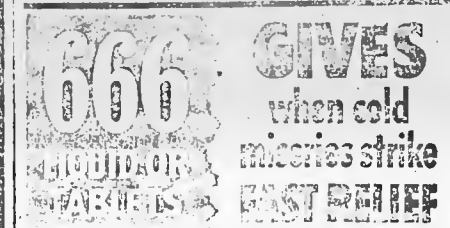
