Lumberton Reports High Leaf Average

Averaging from \$1 to \$2 above the rest of the Border Belt and from \$2 to \$4 above the East, the Lumberton Tobacco Market held its red-hot pace right on into the middle of its 4th week without

the slightest sign of a let-up. The Border Belt leaf capital, which has been hitting a million pounds or more a day all this week and last, is still averaging right at \$51 for the whole season, and many warehousemen and buyers here predict this figure will go up when the growers start bringing in their top quality center leaves.

Official Government figures show that Lumberton opened with a \$52.45 average for the first week hit a season high of \$55.81 on Monday of the second week, rose to an average of \$52.81 the second week, and dropped back to \$40.89 last week.

Choice cutters and top smoking leaf were bringing 65 and 66 cents up one row and down another. The few occasional piles of choice wrappers soare all the way from 70 cents to \$1. Even the common grades seemed somewhat stronger, and the green looked to be the highest of the whole season.
