ed about one-third as well as cutting the amount of plant bed fertilizer in half.

After the land has been disked and smoothed, work two-thirds of the mixture in the soil with a light harrow. Then broadcast the other one-third of the weed killer and rake or harrow in the top inch of soil. Before leaving the bed ditch it to prevent surface water from washing in weed seed during the winter.

Sometime in October we are planning to set up two or three demonstrations using the new 16-2-2 fertilizer to replace the use of weed killer in the fall then fertilizer at seeding. In experimenting with this fertilizer it is hoped that this one application will be sufficient to kill the weeds as well as furnish enough plant food to grow a crop of plants. Some companies are manufacturing this fertilizer in small quantities and where farmers buy it for plant beds, it is suggested that they use it only on a small portion of their total yards.

Get those permanent pastures seeded as soon as possible and your winter cover crops.
