as for Hornworm. Aphids: 1% Parathion dust using 12 to 25 lbs per acre; or Use Parathion spray - 1 lb of

15% wettable powder to 60 gallons water and use 40 to 80 gallons per acre; or 20% Toxaphene dust using 20 lbs per acre; or

1/2 pint 40% or 1 pint 20%, or 2 pints 10% TEPP to 50 gallons of water. Apply 40-80 gallons per acre. This mixture must be used within 1 hour of mixing; or 1% TEPP dust. 12-25 lbs per acre

water.. Use 15-20 lbs and scatter Carolina crotalaria seed for sale in late afternoon.

Vegetable Weevil: Use 5% DDT at the rate of 6 to 10 lbs pe racre on plants.

Heavy residues of any insecticide may cause buyer discrimination, therefore heavy doses should be avoided just before priming as far as possible.

Many insecticides are dangerous to handle an duse. and the precautions recommended by the manufacturer should be followed. This is particularly true of Parathion and TEPP.


