Turkish Tobacco

"Tricky" is the word for Turkish aromatic tobacco, cays William D. Lee, soil specialist for the State College Extension Service. In fact, says Lee, Turkish leaf probably is the "trickiest" crop grown commercially in the State. tended a meeting of agents from It is far more responsive to nitrothe Southeastern District in Fay- gen and organic residues in the soil than are any other crops.

For example, Lee asserts, an application of only 10 pounds of nitrogen per acre, made on a field which apparently needs a "stimulant," will cause rapid growth with thick, dark-green leaves and resultant low quality.

> Summing up, Lee says the more suitable soil conditions for Turkish tobacco appear to be: (1) medium-thick loams with moderately open subsoils, (2) a moderate level land) and no freshly turned or recently added organic material. Manure should be worked into the soil in late fall or early inter ahead of the aromatic tobacco crop. Fallturned lespedeza is all right but probably, it is better to avoid a field where clover has been grown the previous year.
