Seeding should be done uniformly and covered lightly - not over 1/2 Inch. The best method of seering is with seeding attachment on a cultipacker. This sows and covers the seed in one operation. The best method of inoculation is to place the seed in an open container such as a tub or pan. Add a small amount of sugar or syrup to a bucket of water. Pour enough of this water on the seed to moisten them. Stir seed to be sure each seed is moistened. Then add the inoculum and mix thoroughly so that each seed is coated with it. If needed add enough cottonseed meal or dry soil to dry the seeds and make




