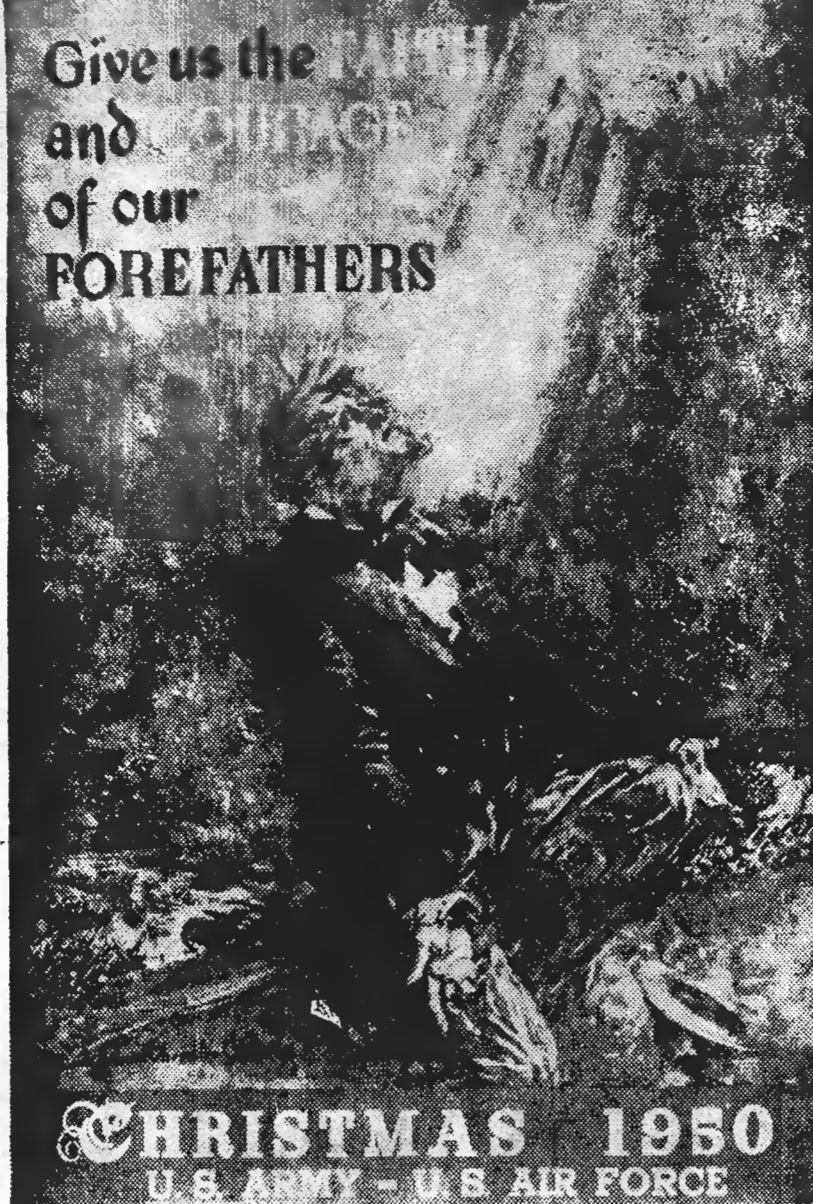

Howard Chandler Christy's Christmas poster for the U. S. Army and the U. S. Air Force is one of the most appropriate to the times ever displayed. Entitled "Give Us the Faith and of our Forefathers," this fine poster portrays Uncle Sam kneeling in prayer with the light coming down from above. Painted originally for the Layman's National Committee of New York City, this Committee made it available on a public service basis to the Army and Air Force Recruiting Service for reproduction as a national Christmas poster. It has already had a most encouraging response. Mr. Christy has done several posters for the Armed Forces, including "Freedom Is Your Business," which appeared nationally during October and November of this year. He has always exhibited a fine public spirit in commemorating the

paintings of notable events and historical personages.

One of his best-known works is the "Signing of the Constitution of the United States," which he was commissioned to paint by the Government. It depicts the signing of our Federal Constitution and is displayed at the Capitol Building, Washington, D. C. The painting is regarded as the greatest picture of that historic occasion ever created by any artist. It was viewed by millions of people while on display with the Freedom Train.

Recently, Mr. Christy, a native Ohioan, painted a mural depicting the life of Thomas Alva Edison. It was presented, with appropriate ceremonies, to the people of Ohio.

Howard Chandler Christy has painted many of the great men of this nation as well as many of the women leaders of society and civic affairs. He has also portrayed most of the great international leaders. One outstanding painting not yet made public is the signing of the United Nations Charter in San Francisco, in 1945.

Fire Chief Lewis Gives Safety Hints On Christmas Trees

Chief Lewis warns that the Christmas tree you are planning to have in your home could be a major hazard unless you take the necessary safety precautions.

The Chief pointed out in connection with the never ending fire prevention campaign of the fire department, and the Junior Chamber of Commerce that tests by the National Board of Fire Underwriters demonstrated that Christmas trees of average size are easily ignited and burn furiously. The blaze could easily start a dangerous fire in the home. The following recommendations in regards to Christmas trees have been made by the National board, and have been passed on by the Fire Department and the Junior Chamber of Commerce.

1. Choose a small tree. It will be less hazardous.
2. Wait until a few days before Christmas to get your tree.
3. Keep the tree outdoors until you are ready to set it up.
4. Place the tree in the coolest place in the house.
5. If a radiator is near the tree, shut it off.
6. Do not use cotton or paper decorations unless they are flame-proofed.
7. Do not place electric trains around tree.
8. Do not use candles. Use electric lights instead.
9. Make certain wires are not frayed. Choose lighting sets approved by the Underwriters Laboratories Inc.

10. Do not plug or unplug lights beneath the tree.
11. Do not leave tree lights burning when there is no one in the house.
12. If needles near the lights turn brown, change the placement of the lights.
13. When needles start to fall take the tree down and discard it.

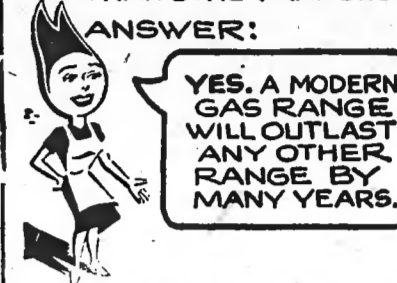

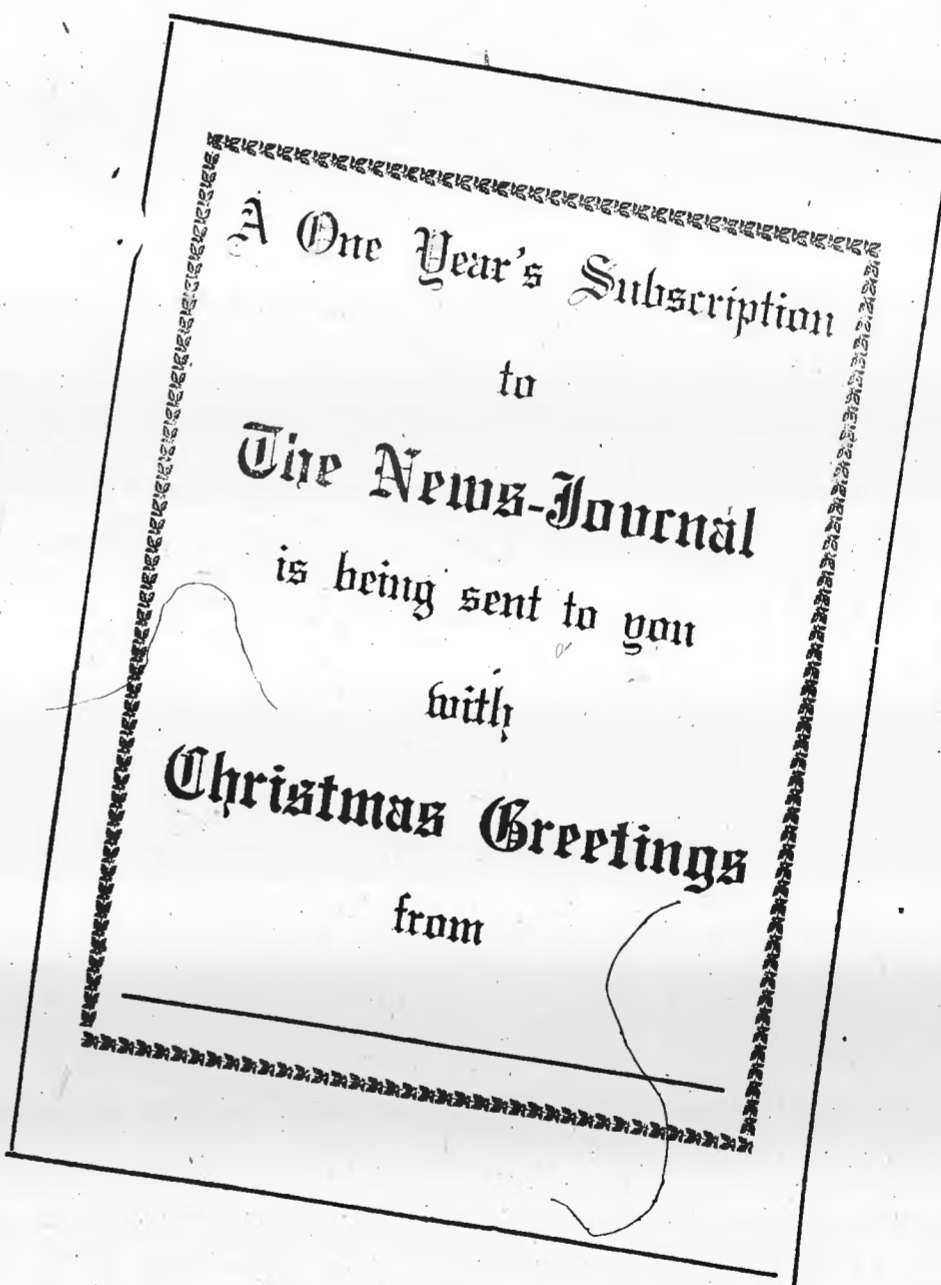

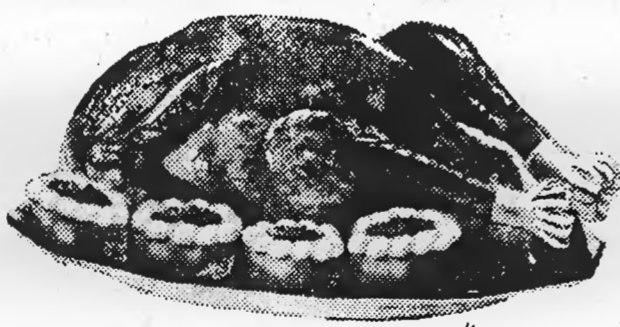
