

Hold Funeral Here For Dougald Lindsay

Dougald J. Lindsay, 83, died in a Fayetteville hospital Sunday morning and was buried in Jacksonville Tuesday afternoon. A native of Cumberland County and for many years a resident of Jacksonville, Fla., he had been visiting his sister, Mrs. Frank Bethea, in Rockfish, for some time.

Funeral services were held at the Lenz Funeral Home here Monday afternoon, conducted by the Rev. B. O. Shannon. Interment followed Tuesday at Evergreen cemetery in Jacksonville. He is survived by one sister and a brother.

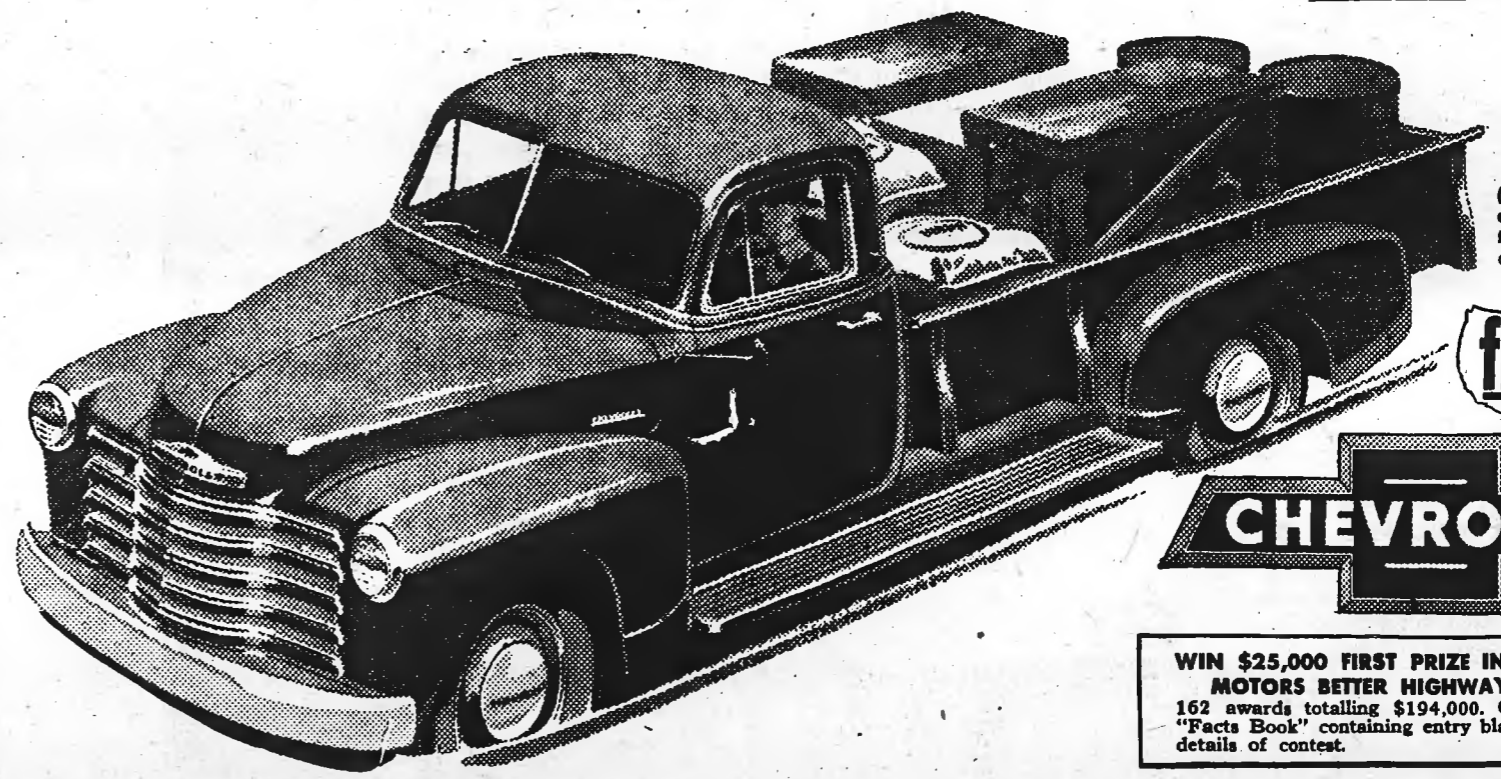
