rioting and looting which broke out over the state the night after King was gunned down in Memphis, Tenn., as he stood on the balcony outside his motel room.

Gov. Dan K. Moore, who ordered the Guard into the affray, was high in his praise of the troops, as well as of state patrolmen and other civilian authorities.

Reports indicated damage was extensive in Wilmington and several other North Carolina cities, but nothing to compare with that sustained in a number of northern metropolitan areas. Hardest hit during the riots appeared to Baltimore and Washington.

Dickson said his men were armed with rifles, pistols, machineguns and tear gas, but did not fire a shot during the fourday stay in the coastal city. They were fired upon several times by snipers, according to reports, and used tear gas on several occasions.

Reports from local Guardsmen who spent the four days in Wilmington indicated most of the trouble came from young Negroes, some apparently as young as 11 and 12 years.

Store windows were broken and considerable looting took place, mostly before the Guard was called out, according to reports. About 15 fires of incendiary origin also were reported.
